A part of the raaco process for the implementation of new suppliers, our supplier questionnaires requests direct confirmation, that materials we purchase do not contain conflict minerals and a self-declaration is also required that the full supply chain process of the suppliers has been examined to confirm this.

In addition, we have also reviewed our existing supply base, and can confirm that none of our suppliers use conflict minerals.
