As part of our product stewardship and regulatory compliance efforts, we continue to monitor potential regulatory, safety, health, and environmental impact of using our products.

California Proposition 65, officially known as the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, became law in November 1986.

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians (and others doing business in the State of California) about significant exposures to chemicals that are known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm.

On August 31, 2016, the State of California Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA) adopted certain amendments to Article 6, Clear and Reasonable Warnings for California Proposition 65 which become effective on August 30, 2018.

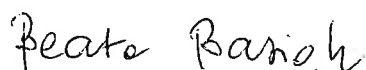
Last update of California Proposition 65 List was published on December 29th, 2023.
